Westside Montessori Lower. It is my pleasure to have your child in my class this 2021-2022 year. I look forward to all that this semester brings.

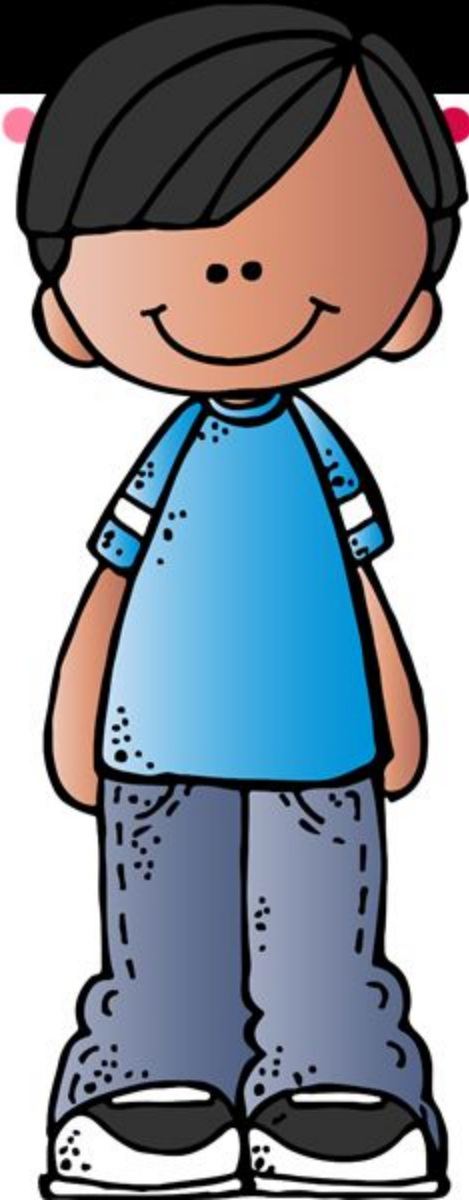

# Class Information

- Weekly newsletters are placed in Purple Folders every Monday unless the school week begins on a different day. It is extremely important to check folders **"DAILY"**.
- Students will be evaluated and graded on assignment agreed upon and assigned by district. Additional grades can be obtained at the teachers discretion as a booster. It is the student's job to complete assignments and turn them in on time.
- Each student will be held accountable for any assignments not turned in, including missed work.
- All missed assignments are made up on **Tuesdays & Wednesdays** of the following week.
  - Homework is **MANDATORY** unless stated otherwise.
- It is important that students are at school daily to ensure that they don't fall behind in classroom lecture.
- Report cards are sent out on a schedule by district and when I receive them, they will be sent.
- Parent/Teacher conferences can be scheduled at any point throughout the semester if there is a need.

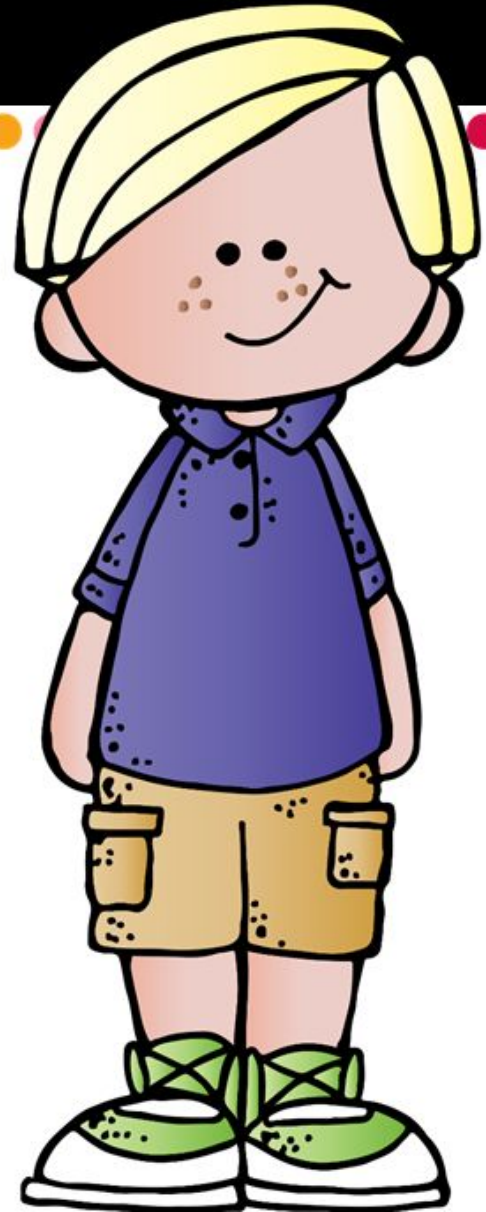

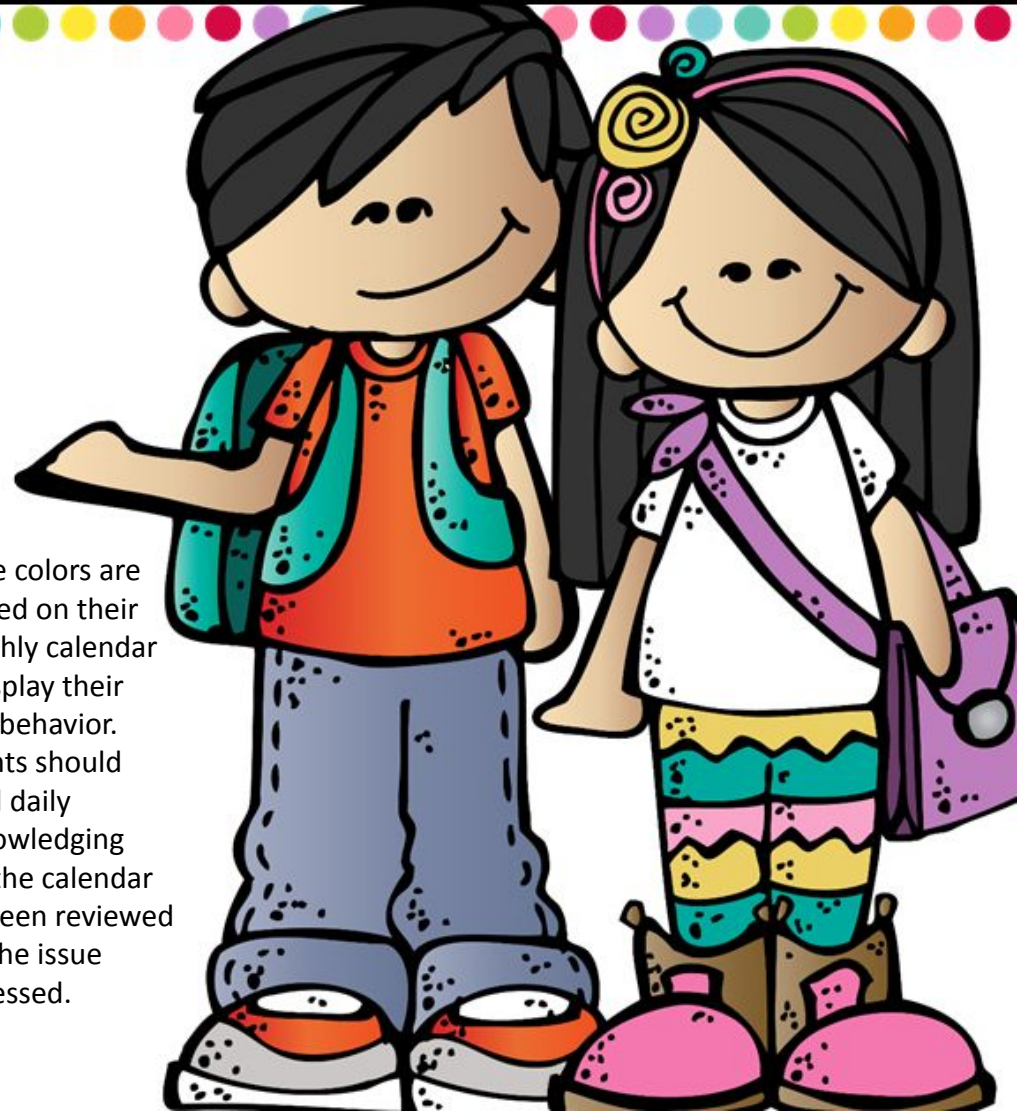

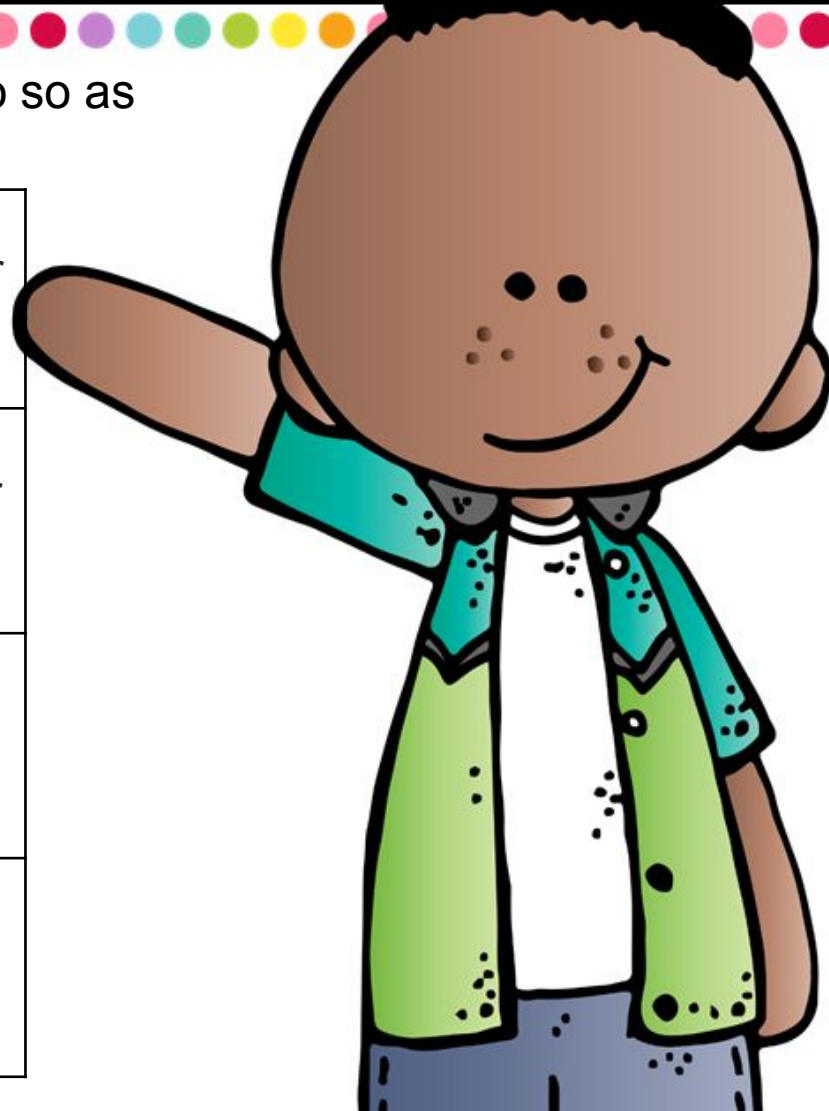
These colors are marked on their monthly calendar to display their daily behavior. Parents should initial daily acknowledging that the calendar has been reviewed and the issue addressed.

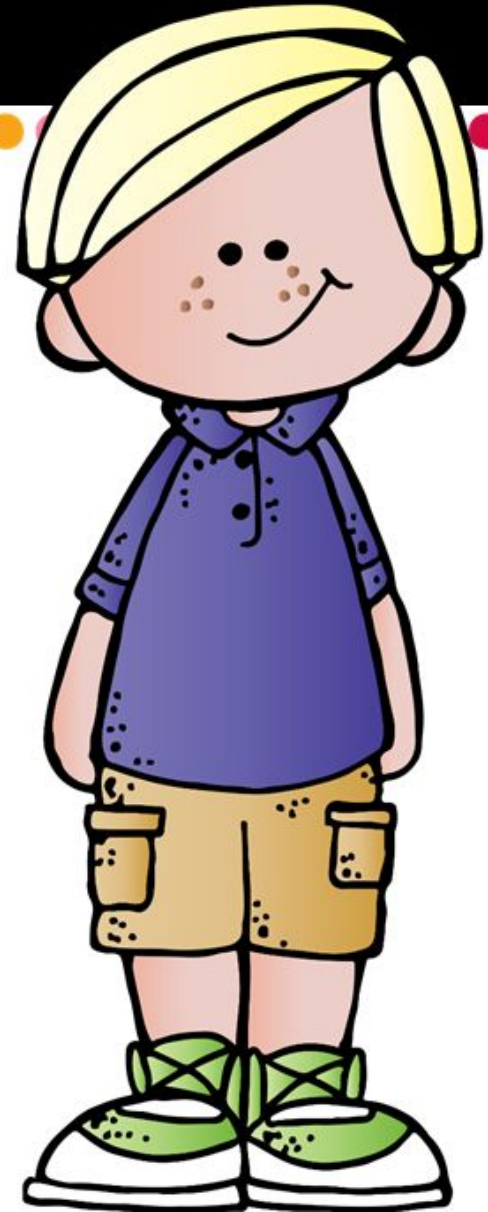
