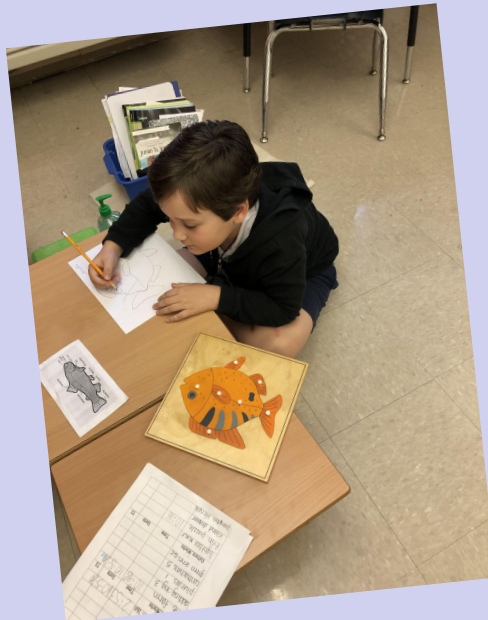
# About Me
