

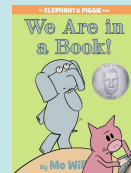

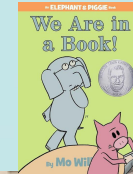

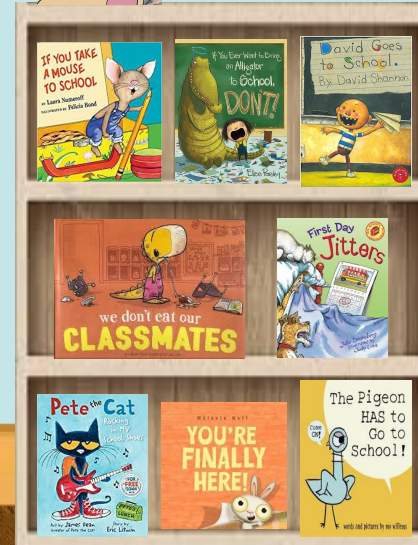

My Classroom

- Here is a picture of our classroom. As you can see the students are arranged in color coded PODS due to the pandemic.
- The students currently eat breakfast, lunch and snack in the classroom
- We wipe tables multiples times daily with disinfectant wipe so if you ever want to donate extra wipes or paper towels, you are more than welcome!

Car and Bus Procedures

- The bell will ring at 8:25 a.m. every day so please make sure your child is at school by this time.

Purple Folder



- This is our most frequent line of communication.
- Please check your child's folder daily.
- Behavior calendar; money slips; absentee notes; correspondence from school.
- Your child will receive a homework packet weekly in their purple folder. The packet is for the week and will be taken on Friday.





Snack

- Your child will eat snack daily.
- Please send a nutritious snack in a small plastic container, outside of their lunch box.
- The plastic box can be put in the front zipper of their backpack where your child can easily access it.
- No candy or juice/soda
- Please provide a water bottle for your child to drink throughout the day.





Extra Clothes

- Please make sure your child has an extra set of clothes in their bag incase of a spill or bathroom accident. This includes underwear, socks, pants, and a shirt.
- Make sure your child has an extra mask in their bag because I have noticed some of the children lose them or they break.
- Dirty clothes will come home in a disposable bag so please replace with new clothes and remove dirty clothes.





Dress Code

- Please follow TPSS dress code
- School Shoes should have a rubber sole and Absolutely NO laces. Please do not send your child in the following: boots, flip flops, shoes without backs, heels, anything other than a tennis shoe. Safety is our number one concern and for multiple reasons anything other than a tennis shoe is not school appropriate.





Grading

- Kindergarten students will be tested on a select set of skills every 9 weeks. This will be an ongoing assessment throughout the school year. Kindergarten conferences are conducted upon request either by parent or teacher.
- Pre-K students will be tested 3 times a year and will have 2 parent/teacher conferences. Both Pre-K assessments and conferences are a requirement of the Pre-K program in our Parish.
